Acquisition of Bartin Recycling completed

The Derichebourg group has declared that the acquisition of Bartin Recycling, former subsidiary of the Veolia group, was completed on November 30, 2016, with all conditions precedent fulfilled. This acquisition was announced on July 21, 2016.

Bartin Recycling is specialized in the collection and recycling of ferrous and nonferrous metals. At around twenty locations in France, the company recycles scrap iron, production off-cuts and demolition waste, from on-site recovery or dismantling to their sale to factories as secondary raw materials.

The firm is a key recycling player in France, recuperating and recycling up to 450,000 tons of metals annually.

The dismantling and deconstruction of end-of-life materials businesses (aviation, maritime, rail) are not included in this sale.

The Derichebourg group is a key player providing services to businesses and municipalities in the international arena. It offers a full and integrated range of services in two complementary business sectors: environmental services (recycling, waste recuperation, household waste collection, urban cleaning, waste center management, etc.), and business services (cleaning, energy, temporary staffing, aeronautics, services in sensitive environments, etc.). The group is currently present in 14 countries across three continents, and has a global workforce of 33,000. The Derichebourg group registered $\in 2.4$ billion in revenue in 2015.
